A Message from our President

Hi Everyone!

When you listened to Governor Joe Lombardo's State of the State address the other night, did you find yourself alarmed at some of his proposals?

Lombardo announced details of his proposed two-year \$11 billion budget which

includes lowering taxes on families and business – while also saving \$1 for every new dollar spent from the general fund. Left with a healthy surplus courtesy of Governor Sisolak, Lombardo also said he would put over \$600 million in the Rainy Day Fund and invest another \$730 million into an education-specific rainy day fund called the Education Stabilization Account.

Doesn't sound awful, right? Except for the part where there's no discussion of where or how these monies will come from or how they will be sustained.

On crime, the former sheriff stated he is submitting proposed legislation to enhance charges for repeat offenders, empower judges and probation officers to impose tougher sanctions for parole violations, and increase penalties for fentanyl possession by making possession of the drug a category B felony, punishable by 1-20 years imprisonment.

On elections, Lombardo said he would eliminate universal voting by mail, require ID at the polls, and require those who do vote by mail to have ballots in by election day, and that if the legislature doesn't help him accomplish these things, he will take them to the public for ballot initiatives. This undoes everything we fought for in 2019 and 2021.

The Democratic rebuttal was beautifully delivered by Assembly Speaker-Elect Steve Yeager.

Senate Majority Leader <u>Nicole Cannizzaro responded strongly</u> to Gov. Lombardo's speech and his executive order that new regulations be frozen and each department propose 10 regulations to be cut.

Roll up your sleeves. We've got more work to do.
